

# 2018 ARIZONA STATE BPCR-V/SNIPER SILHOUETTE CHAMPIONSHIP

**LOCATION:** Ben Avery Shooting Facility, Phoenix Arizona, located approximately 15 miles North of Metro Phoenix at Carefree Highway, Exit 223, Off I-17. Once on the Facility, follow the signs to the Rifle Silhouette Range.

**MATCH DATE:** Saturday, November 10<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018  
The Range is Open for Practice on Friday, November 9<sup>th</sup>

**No Morning Practice on Match Days**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to U.S. Citizens or Non-Citizens who are members of their National Shooting Organization.

**RULES:** Black Powder Silhouette. CMP Vintage Sniper Rules. Empty chamber indicators are required, and eye and ear protection are required.

**JURY:** A Jury of 3 competitors will be selected to render final decisions on all disputes concerning equipment, conditions and/or procedures. **No protests after daily scores are posted.**

**CLASSIFICATION:** NRA Classifications for Blackpowder Silhouette will apply. NRA scorebooks must be presented at registration. Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master Class for Match 1 only. Scorebooks will NOT be available for sale at the range. Vintage Sniper Rifle competitors may use their BPC Classifications found in NRA Rulebook.

**MATCH SCHEDULE:** MATCH #1—40 shot matches @ 08:30 Sat., 11/10/2017  
MATCH #2—40 shot matches @ 08:30 Sun., 11/11/17  
MATCH #3—Arizona State Championship—Aggregate of #1 and #2

**CONDITIONS:** Competitors may choose to shoot any of the following matches: 80 Shot Iron Sight Championship, the 80 Shot Scope Championship, or the 80 Shot Vintage Sniper Championship. It is the shooter's responsibility to work out the details with his or her spotter if opting for additional class.

Animal count for Matches 1 and 2 will decide ties with shoot-offs for the Aggregate Match Only (time and conditions permitting). In the event of high winds, the match will be shot on swinger targets.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$120.00 Iron Sight Championship (2 Days)  
\$120.00 Scope Championship (2 Days)  
\$120.00 Vintage Sniper Rifle Championship (2 Days)  
\$90.00 Additional Class

Entry Fee includes dinner, individual match fees, ASRPA and Range Use fees for 11/9 – 11/11/18.

**REFUNDS:** There are no refunds after October 1, 2018. No exceptions.

**SQUADDING:** This event will consist of 2 relays, with a maximum of 64 shooters. Squadding partners should be indicated on the entry form. Every attempt will be made to accommodate special requests.

**TARGET SETTERS:** Target setters will be provided for both days of competition, but shooters can shoot swinger targets or reset their own targets for Friday Practice Day.

**RIFLES AND EQUIPMENT:** All rifles, ammunitions, sights and cross-sticks must conform to current BPCR or CMP Vintage Sniper Rules. This year Vintage Sniper rifles can be shot from sandbags OR cross-sticks.

Open bolt indicators and 5-Shot Blocks are mandatory. Handling rifles on the firing line during target setting is strictly prohibited.

BPC Competitors **are required** to have a container to catch dirty patches at the ends of their barrels. Failure to clean up patches at the end of your relay may result in disqualification.

**AWARDS:**

- Arizona State Iron Sight Champion, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Buckles
- Arizona State Scope Champion, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Buckles
- Vintage Sniper State Champion, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Buckles
  
- Master, AAA, AA, A/B Class Medals: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.
- High Senior: Medals.
- Dan Theodore Best Spotter: Medal for Top Iron Sight and Scope Spotters.
  
- Medals for Match 1 and Match 2 Winners, as well as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in Master, AAA, AA, and A/B.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** The shooting line and preparation areas are covered. Preparation tables are provided but limited. Competitors are encouraged to bring their own folding chairs and tables. A drinking fountain, picnic tables and permanent restrooms are provided at the Silhouette Range.

**SATURDAY BARBEQUE:** A Barbeque will be held for all competitors after the Saturday Match.

**ACCOMODATIONS:** There is a full hook-up campground located at the Main Range. For reservations, call the range office (623-582-8313 and push "0" for details). Numerous motels are located within 10 minutes of the range.

The Hampton Inn in Anthem, AZ, has a special rate for Ben Avery Shooters, arranged by the AZ Sporting Clay Association. Travelers can call hotel directly and ask for ASCA rate at 623-465-7979.
